# Principle 2 Officials Game Responsibilities

Equally share in control:

- A decision by any one is valid
- All record misconduct to assure completeness

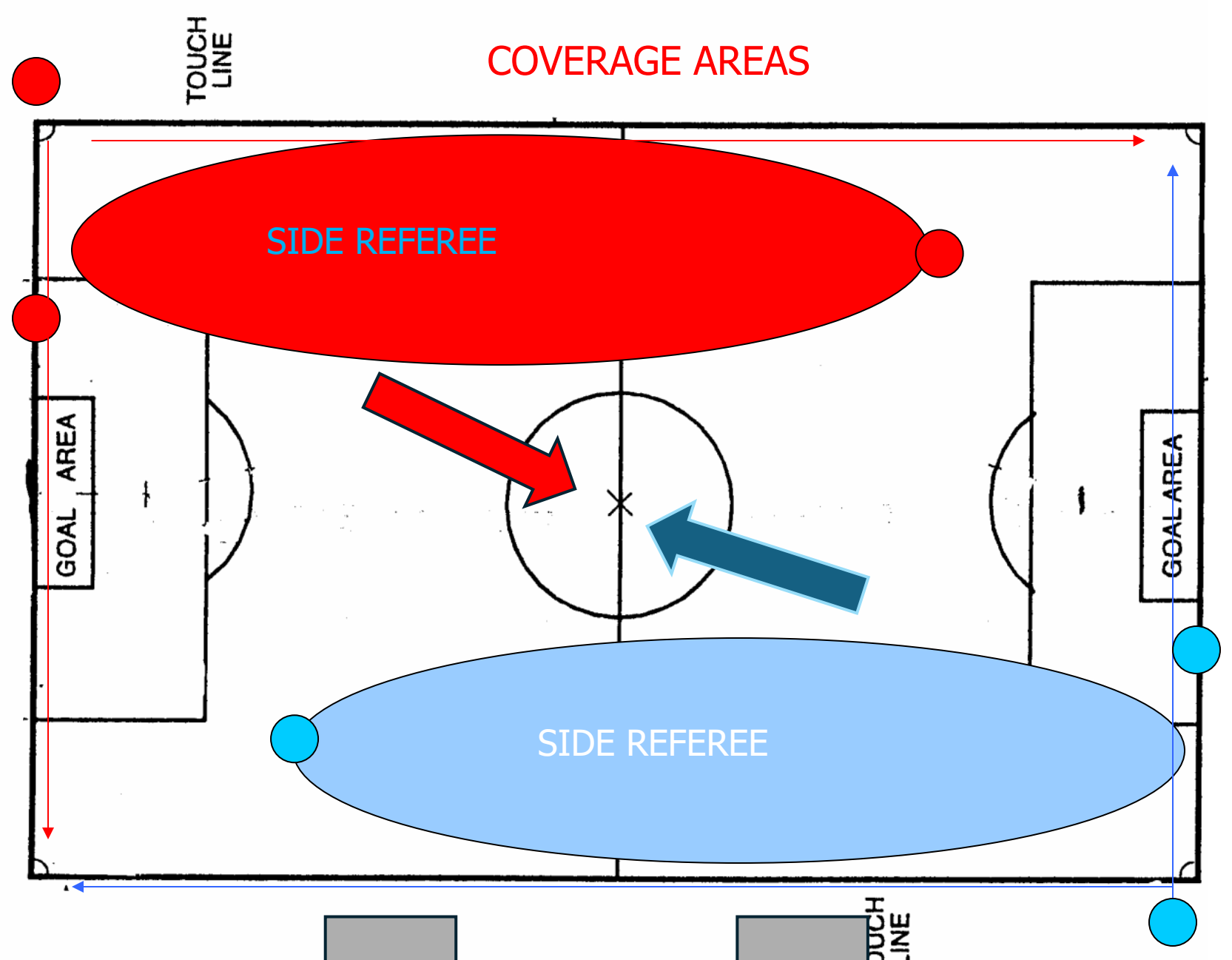
Concentrate attention in specific areas:

- Where referee field coverage patterns make observation most effective.
- Trail referee covers midfield while lead official is advancing with the offside line
- Either is responsible for violations not clearly seen by the other.

# Referee Responsible for Managing Restart and Second Whistles (when required)

Can be modified with Pre-Game discussions

Restart	Referee whistle (if required)
1. Start of Play	Trailing
2. Free Kicks	Leading ( <i>except if deep in defensive end</i> )
3. Offside	Trailing (closest to Offside restart)
4. Substitution	Bench side official ( <i>whistle for sub</i> ) (restart referee closest to ball)
5. Corner Kick	Referee covering the goal line
6. Goal Kick	Referee closest to restart
7. Penalty Kick	Both referees should participate (goal line coverage and kicker/encroachment)
8. Throw in	Referee closest to throw
9. Drop Ball	(offensive official not dropping the ball)
10 Signals	Referee calling foul signal direction/ Throw-in/corner referee closest to play signals direction/ both indicate IFK
